A list of breed & obedience prizes & trophies offered may be obtained by writing the Show Secretary at the address shown above. The Cocker Spaniel Specialty Club of Dallas reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ENTRY FEE (includes \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee) first entry of each dog—\$27.00, except Puppy Class—\$15.00. Bred By Exhibitor—\$15.00. Sweepstakes—\$15.00. Best of Variety—\$27.00. Obedience—\$25.00. The CSSCD assumes the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. Non-Regular class—\$15.00. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. The CSSCD reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in being put on a Cash Only basis. Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other source beyond the control of the CSSCD. Facsimile entries will not be accepted by CSSCD. No entries shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Entries will not be accepted that require a SIGNATURE for delivery

General Information

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 12:00 noon, Thursday, March 19, 2009. The committee reserves the right to alter this time depending on weather conditions and/or the condition of the building. Unloading will be supervised by members of Clubs or their designated representatives, to insure orderly access into the building. All dogs must be removed from the show site by one hour following the completion of Best In Show on Sunday, March 22, 2009. The Exhibit Building is climate controlled. NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES ARE ALLOWED

The Cocker Spaniel Specialty Club of Dallas, Fort Worth Kennel Club, Show Superintendent, or the City of Fort Worth will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the show buildings or on the grounds at Will Rogers Complex.

Exhibitors are expected to comply with all Club rules as laid out and enforced by the Fort Worth Kennel Club, Inc. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations, and state health certificates. Dogs may not be exercised outside the show building on the grass or sidewalks or paved parking lots of Will Rogers Complex, the Museum or the Art Center. Groups may be judged two at a time. All catalogs will be sold. None will be given away. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. A night watchman will be on duty Thursday through Saturday night as a courtesy only. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when exercising. Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building. The Fort Worth Kennel Club, Inc. is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show. There will be no space provided for un-entered dogs at this show.

Grooming and Crating

The grooming areas and crating set up in the Large Exhibit Building will be handled in the following manner: A member of the Show Committee will direct every exhibitor with the EXACT placement of their crates, grooming tables, etc for their area. EACH designated grooming space will be split length ways down the middle with tape. All crates will be placed in an IDENTICAL FASHION, as directed by the Show Committee. Crating and grooming areas are allotted on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis. No crating inside any building may be reserved or saved by roping off, placing cones, chairs, tables, equipment or any other means you may think to employ. No crates or grooming tables of any size will be allowed at ring side. The Club reserves the right to restrict the number of grooming tables and to rearrange grooming areas and set-ups as required by circumstances for the safety and convenience of all. THIS INCLUDES MOVING CRATES, TABLES AND OTHER EQUIPMENT. **ALL CRATES, INCLUDING WIRE CRATES, MUST BE STACKED.** Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates. No rugs are allowed in the grooming area. Ringside chairs are NOT to be taken to grooming area. No personal chairs at ring side. **Absolutely no private exercise pens** will be allowed in the Exhibits Building at any time. **Public exercise pens** will be provided and must be attended by owner or handler while in use. Crates may not be set up in the west lot or in the area north of the building. All private exercise pens outside the building must be in areas designated by the Club. No dogs or crates are permitted in the underground garage.

Parking to unload: 20 minutes only. Violators are subject to ticketing.

As scheduling allows, 5-10 minute breaks will be provided between sweeps and regular classes and between varieties to allow exhibitors time to get dogs to the rings since ringside crating is usually not allowed by the FWKC grooming/show committee.

Transfer Of Entry To Best Of Breed

Effective for all shows held after July 1, 1990, dogs which, according to the owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

The following regular classes will be provided for each of the 3 varieties for both dogs and bitches:
Puppy 6 mo. and under 9 mo. Puppy 9 mo. and under 12 mo. 12 mo. to 18 mo.
Novice Bred By Exhibitor American Bred Open Best of Variety

Non-Regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:
Veterans (7 years or older) Best Bred By Exhibitor

Rosettes

Rosettes will be offered for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of each Variety, Best Opposite Sex to Best of each Variety, Best in Sweepstakes, Best Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes, Best of each Variety in Sweepstakes, and Best Opposite Sex to Best of each Variety in Sweepstakes.

Regular Class Trophies

Trophies will be offered for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex to Best of Breed; In all 3 varieties: Best of Variety, Best Opposite Sex to Best of Variety, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Winners AND in Obedience.

Puppy Sweepstakes

Dogs shown in Puppy Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular fee for the first entry. Enter "Puppy Sweepstakes" as an additional class. Classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches in all three varieties as: 6 mo. and under 9 mo.; 9 mo. and under 12 mo. After retaining 40% of the total sweepstakes entry money for Club expenses, the balance will be divided as follows among the 3 varieties:

Best of Each Variety: 6%; Best Opposite in Each Variety: 6%
 Best Opposite to Best in Sweepstakes: 6%
 Best Puppy in Sweepstakes: 18%

Puppy Sweepstakes trophies will be awarded to the Best of Each Variety, Best Opposite to Best Puppy and Best Puppy in Sweepstakes.

CUT DOWN Sweepstakes

Dogs shown in CUT DOWN Sweepstakes need NOT be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular fee for the first entry. Enter "CUT DOWN Sweepstakes" as an additional class. Classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches in all three varieties. After retaining 40% of the total sweepstakes entry money for Club expenses, the balance will be divided as follows among the 3 varieties:

Best of Each Variety: 3%; Best Opposite in Each Variety: 3%
 Best Opposite to Best in CUT DOWN Sweepstakes: 18%
 Best in CUT DOWN Sweepstakes: 24%

Trophies will be awarded to the Best Opposite and Best in CUT DOWN Sweepstakes.

VETERAN Sweepstakes

Dogs shown in VETERAN Sweepstakes need NOT be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular fee for the first entry. Enter "VETERAN Sweepstakes" as an additional class. Classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches in all three varieties. After retaining 40% of the total sweepstakes entry money for Club expenses, the balance will be divided as follows among the 3 varieties:

Best of Each Variety: 3%; Best Opposite in Each Variety: 3%
 Best Opposite to Best in CUT DOWN Sweepstakes: 18%
 Best in CUT DOWN Sweepstakes: 24%

Trophies will be awarded to the Best Opposite and Best in VETERAN Sweepstakes.

PARKING REGULATIONS

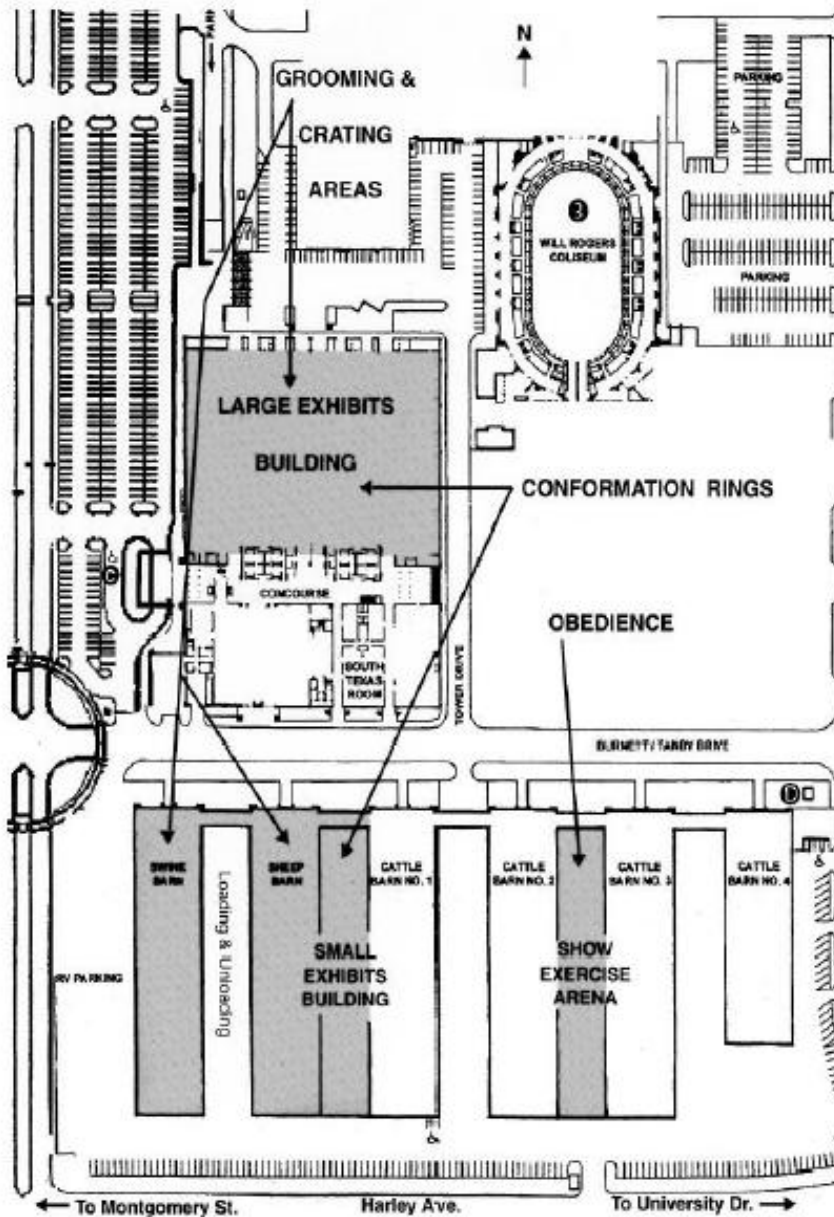
Parking to unload: 20 minutes only! Violators are subject to being ticketed and towed. No RV or trailer parking in the lot to the west of the Large Exhibits Building. There are RV hookups & a dump station in the lot south of Harley at Montgomery Street and in the area next to the Swine Building: \$15.00 per night, no reservations. Contact Will Rogers Memorial Center, 1 Amon Carter Square, Fort Worth TX 76107 - (817) 871-8150 for information & payment. **ALL VEHICLES LARGER THAN THE STANDARD VAN MUST PARK IN THE LOTS ONE BLOCK SOUTH OF THE MUSEUM OF SCIENCE AND HISTORY on Harley/Montgomery.** The area next to the Swine Building is paid RV parking ONLY.

RV lots on Harley Street and west of the Swine Barn will have water and hookups. No water or hookups in Rip Johnson Lot.

Loading & unloading is permitted at the north end of the Large Exhibit Building on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the north entrance of the building and from the west parking lot in the area of the steps leading to the north entrance. Loading and unloading of dogs is permitted on the south side of the Small Exhibits Building and between the Swine and Sheep Barns. Parking on marked lots will have to be inside the designated lines. No vehicles will be permitted to extend into the fire lanes. No single vehicle will be permitted to occupy more than one space.

All parking will be on a **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED** basis. Spaces may not be saved. Positively no dumping of drain or holding tanks. Filling of water tanks from any water source on the Will Rogers Complex will not be permitted.

The Show Committee reserves the right to enter or authorize entrance to a vehicle using whatever means necessary to rescue dogs in distress. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.



ROUTES TO THE SHOW

I-30 East or West exit Montgomery St N to Burnett-Tandy. Turn right on Burnett-Tandy to show building. For unloading, turn left behind building, on Tower Rd. For sheep & swine barns, continue to unloading area at rear of building for sheep etc. Unload on west side.
